



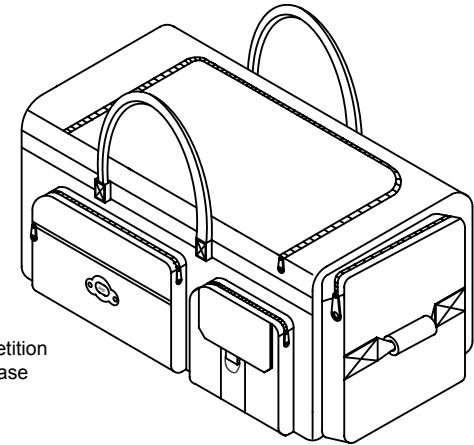

Operating Instructions

Connect the lights, power supply and buzzer as shown below. Plug power supply into wall outlet and let games begin.

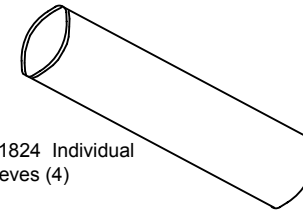
To add additional modules, just unplug the buzzer from the last module and plug in as many additional modules as required, then plug the buzzer into the last module.

If more space is desired between modules, simply connect a 48" extension between the two modules that can be connected together, if the buzzer is not required, simply disconnect.

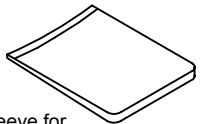

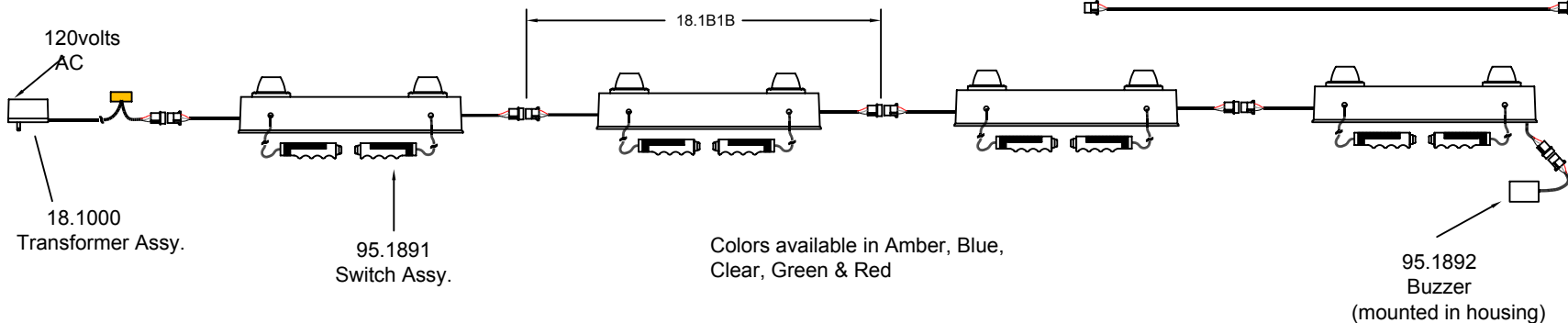
90.65096 Competition Light Carrying Case
